That's why the development application by IC & L to construct a cement terminal at White Bay must be rejected by the NSW Government.

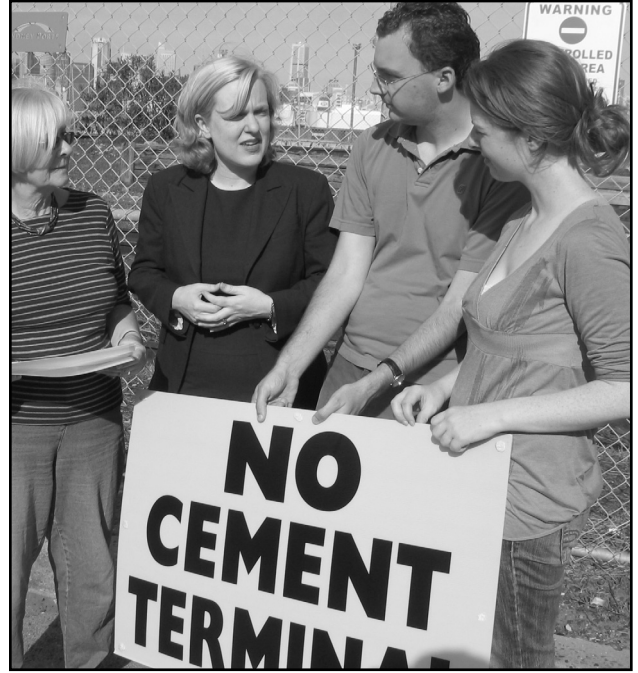
